

TAKING CARE OF OLDER ADULTS

Jewish Detroit is home to 17,000 older adults, 25% of whom rely on services from Federation's agencies and organizations. The population of older adults is expected to grow by as much as 16% by 2025.

As these individuals live longer, needs will continue to grow, especially since many do not have the financial means to sustain a comfortable and healthy life in their later years. Many are currently struggling to make ends meet.

Federation is working with our partner agencies to ease the increasing strain on the community's social safety net and to pursue innovative strategies to expand senior services.

Together, we are exploring affordable housing solutions, developing incentives to attract and retain care providers, examining new operational models and considering new revenue sources to ensure that older adults have access to the support they need to live with comfort and dignity.

'Honor your Mother and Father' is a central commandant of the Torah, and a reminder that prioritizing services for older adults in the coming years is not just a practical need, it is a moral imperative that reflects the essence of our Jewish values.



Even with an improving economy, many Jewish Detroiters continue to face economic hardships, such as food insecurity, mounting bills, prohibitive childcare expenses, dwindling savings and the resulting toll of stress and anxiety. A recent study reported that 28% of metro Detroit Jewish community members are struggling to make ends meet.

Judaism teaches that everyone has a responsibility to give to those in need. Support for Federation's Annual Campaign directly impacts these pressures. Working with our human services partners, we're actively helping community members find their footing and progress towards stability and independence.

For example, Jewish Family Service offers an array of essential resources, counseling and advocacy to help households get back on their feet. Gesher Human Services provides career coaching on top of vocational training and Hebrew Free Loan helps put business, personal and educational goals within financial reach.

But growing needs throughout the community, along with rising costs of services, mean that greater resources are needed to fulfill our mission of ensuring the welfare of the most vulnerable members of our community.

COMMUNITY RESILIENCE & PREPAREDNESS

The statistics are alarming: In 2022, there were a recorded 3,697 antisemitic incidents throughout the United States, a 36% increase from 2021 and the highest number on record since we began tracking antisemitic incidents.

Sadly, these trends have been seen across metro Detroit. A growing number of antisemitic hate crimes, including acts of vandalism, threats and harassment, were reported at Jewish businesses and community institutions, including synagogues, schools and college campuses.

The safety and security of the community is an essential part of Federation's mission. The Annual Campaign, along with other funding sources, provides for a robust security infrastructure.


SUPPORT FOR ISRAEL & **JEWS AROUND THE WORLD**
